### Recommendations

### **Election Policy**

### Add: Limit on Position Sought

A member is limited to seek nomination for one position per election cycle. Should a member be found to be seeking nominations for multiple positions, that Member will be treated as having not registered as a Nominee and will not be considered for candidacy for any position.

### Change: Section 80.08 Campaign Material Limitations

Suggestion: I would like to mandate that all Presidents must make a 3 x 7 banner which will hang in the Windows of the CAW Commons area during the Election. Banners must be up and ready for Poster Night. Posters can be approved early.

Suggestion: Banner size wording should be revised

Change: Overlap or be attached to any hung or posted campaign material of another candidate by one (1) inch or cover any words of another candidates banner or poster.

### Add: 120.01 Submitting Complaints

Any allegations of violations of the Election Policy must be submitted to the CRO. The last day to submit complaints is the day after the last day of voting at 6:00 pm Any complaints submitted, which involve University of Windsor campus police to investigate will be extended until proof of allegations have been confirmed.

#### Add: Reimbursements

A new section needs to be added regarding Reimbursements. Clear rules need to be established regarding reimbursements and penalties to candidates.

### Add: New Policy on Referendum

- Detailing requirements and timelines
- Any referendum which involves a contract must uphold due diligence by the UWSA and the petitioner.
- The UWSA must investigate the contents of the question with all parties involved before it is sent out to the membership.

### Add: New Policy for Candidates that are disqualified

• Candidates that are disqualified from a General Election cannot run in the up-coming by-election.

### **Suggestions**

### **Reduce Voting Day**

- 1 day for Voting
- Reduces administration costs
- Less stress on candidates
- Create marketing campaign focusing on locations and "promoting the vote"
- In line with Provincial and Federal Elections

### **Campaigning during Voting Days**

- Change policy so Candidates can Campaign during Voting Days
- Will add more excitement
- We can't control Social Media Campaigning
- Candidates will NOT be allowed to send messages asking people to vote for certain people
- NO interviews with MEDIA during Voting Days

#### **Election Committee**

- Outsourced CRO (April Adams) is responsible for hiring the Election Committee
  - o Students were approached by certain individuals to apply for the position.
  - o Board Members that Vote for EC, is a conflict of interest.

### **Voting Website**

- CRO found the voting website to be time consuming and confusing for voters.
- SAVE button needs improvement.
- Research different ways to Vote on-line.

#### **Voting Administration**

- The Vote administration site should be reviewed with the CRO and IT services to enhance its capabilities.
- The following areas need upgrading: testing/verifying data entries, timeline, and statistics and the voting process.
- The CRO has reviewed the last three Election reports and believe the actual turnout of voters is incorrect.
- The Voting statistics can provide useful information to the UWSA when it comes to who is voting and when. A strategy can be better utilized when it comes to marketing towards specific faculties with low turnout, the advantage/disadvantage to hiring poll clerks and voter turnout on specific days.

#### **Election Manual**

An Election Manual needs to be developed. As a new CRO there are many aspects to running an election within the University of Windsor that a new CRO is unaware of.

The Election Manual can provide information regarding all aspects of running an election; who to contact regarding Voter lists for each Faculty, how to set-up the Vote administration site, contact information for catering, stage set-up and video equipment.

### **Society Elections**

Many new students are not well informed of the Election process. An Election Guide and Forms should be available to all Society's to better assist them in an Election for their Executive members and staff.

All Society constitutions need to be reviewed and updated. Society Elections should be the same for all Society's.

### **Election Policy**

CRO would like to review the entire Policy and make recommendations to the Board before the next Election.
