Recommendations

Election Policy

Include and Change:

Material restrictions are not included in the election policy, but there is a separate document existing that does need to be changed as well. Campaign materials must be included in the Election Policy. The existing regulation on banners is confusing and needs to be re-written. Here follows my recommendation:

- a) no more than five (5) banners are allowed. Banners must not exceed 3' x 7' or twenty one (21) square feet in total (for executive positions)
- b) no more than three (3) banners are allowed. Banners must not exceed 3' x 7' or twenty one (21) square feet in total (for all other positions)

The Penalties and Appeals form that outlines the procedure for complaints and appeals should be included in the Election policy as well.

Add: Submitting Complaints

Any allegations of violations of the Election Policy must be submitted to the CRO. Allegations must be made within forty-eight (48) hours of the violation. Sitting on known violations (alleged) until after elections is over shouldn't be an option as a last resort.

Voting Website and Administration

CRO found the voting website to glitch a lot. Student numbers are already in the list, but need to be added manually for them to be able to vote in certain cases.

The Vote administration site should be reviewed with the CRO and IT services to enhance its capabilities.

The following areas need upgrading: clearing out previous votes in the system and a lot of unnecessary data on the website from previous elections need to be cleared. Only IT can do this, and provides as a hassle every election.

Election Manual

An Election Manual needs to be developed for the CRO's office. As a new CRO there are many aspects to running an election within the University of Windsor that a new CRO is unaware of.

The Election Manual can provide information regarding all aspects of running an election; who to contact regarding Voter lists for each Faculty, how to set-up the Vote administration site, contact information for catering, stage set-up and video equipment.

Society Elections

Many new students are not well informed of the Election process. An Election Guide and Forms should be available to all Society's to better assist them in an Election for their Executive members and staff.

Campaign Rules

Section 70.02 subsection 10 of Unpaid Leave should include all employees of the UWSA, both paid and unpaid positions to maintain a standard of fairness in the elections.
